During the Guarantee/warranty period, desired uptime of 95% of 365 days (24 hrs) if downtime more than 5% the institute shall be entitled to impose penalty in the form of extended warranty period equal to twice the downtime period. The vendor must undertake to supply all spares for optimal upkeep of the equipment for at least FIVE YEARS after handing over the unit to the Centre. If accessories/other attachment of the system are procured from the third party, then the vendor must produce cost of accessory/other attachment and the CAMC from the third party separately along with the main offer and the third party will have to sign the CAMC with the Institute if required.

- 42. The principals or their agents are required to submit a certificate that they have satisfactory service arrangements and fully trained staff available to support the uptime guarantee.
- 43. - **Delivery:** The successful bidders should strictly adhere to the following delivery schedule supply, installation & Commissioning should be effected within 6 to 8 weeks from the date of supply order and this clause should be strictly adhere to failing which administrative action as deemed fit under rules will be taken against the defaulter.
- 45. **SPARE PARTS:** The separate price list of all spares and accessories and consumables, if any, (Including minor) required for maintenance and repairs in future after guarantee/warrantee period must be attached/enclosed along with the sealed quotation failing which quotation will not be considered.
 - If any spares & accessories other than the price list attached/enclosed by the firm are required for future repair it will be borne by the firm only.
- 46. The tenderers are required to furnish the list of spares along with their cost in the financial bid failing which their bids are liable to be rejected.
- 47. The tenderer shall furnish a non-blacklisting certificate that the firm has not been blacklisted in the past by any government/Private institution. - 48. Payment of Agency Commission, if any, payable in rupees must be indicated. If no Agency Commission is admissible from the foreign suppliers must be indicated specifically.
- 49. Tenderers should clearly indicate the name of the Manufacturers/Beneficiary of the Letter of Credit, country of Origin, place of shipment/Airfreightment, etc.
- 50. Local agents quoting on behalf of their foreign suppliers must attach valid authority letter in their favour. In case of distributor, the firm should be direct distributor from the principal's.  - "I/We certify that the Stores of description identical to the Stores supplied to the government under the contract against Tender herein have not been offered/sold by me/us to any other person/organization/Institution upto date of bill/the date of completion of supplies against all supply orders placed during the currency of the tender/rate contract at the price lower than the institute under contract /against tender".
- 56. The supplier shall furnish a list of organizations where the equipment, in question, has/have been supplied with the period during the last one year and performance certificate from such organization may also be provided.
